Western Washington University's College of Fine and Performing Arts, Bellingham, Washington, where she has established a thriving string program built upon an intensive chamber music curriculum. She founded the WWU Preparatory Music Program in 1987, an enrichment program for 120 schoolchildren ages 5 through 18. The program includes youth symphonies, chorus, piano ensembles, folk music, and chamber music. A unique feature is the Teacher Training Institute, a practical teaching opportunity for Music Education majors.

Iglitzin received her B.A. at Indiana University with Josef Gingold and her M.A. with Joseph Silverstein at Yale School of Music. As first violinist of the Philadelphia String Quartet from 1982 to 1986, she toured India, South America and the United States.

She gives numerous workshops around the Pacific Northwest for students as well as teachers, coaches high school and middle school string programs, and is a frequent adjudicator and lecturer.

Editor's Note: Unless teachers have read a great deal of chamber music or are professional chamber musicians themselves, it is very difficult to know what music to assign a young ensemble. In fact, even if teachers do make their living performing chamber music, the ideas and layout of this article will prove to be very useful and interesting.

I feel Karen Iglitzin has provided us all with a much needed tool for teaching student ensembles of all ages and levels of accomplishment. She does warn, however, that she is "not responsible for any dire consequences which might result from student performances of these works"! [R.H.]
